# Sightseeing

### BAReNA

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Visit the charming café BAReNA at the northern tip of La Certosa island. They sell delicious sandwiches and beverages that you can bring on board for your picnic sailing adventure.

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# Flamingo watching

If you are lucky, you might catch a sight of the beautiful flamingos around these shallow banks.

### Supermarket and free mooring

Restock on cold drinks and snacks at supermercato Vignotto, or go to the back of the shop and have the friendly butcher make a fresh sandwich with local prosciutto and cheese. Check online for opening hours.

## The monastery of San Francesco del Deserto

Experience this historical island from the waterside. The island is home of a Franciscan Monastery that was founded in 1230, and the monastery remains active to this day. The island is surrounded by sandbanks and is wrapped around its perimeter by cypresses and pines. Free mooring, first come first served. Check online for opening hours.

#### Burano

Burano is an island known for its colorful houses and traditional lace making, including a museum. Its densely packed streets are filled with sidewalk cafes and classic trattorias serving up seafood dishes.

#### Mazzorbo

If you wish to explore the island of Burano, you can take advantage of free mooring at Mazzorbo and walk over the bridge to Burano. On Mazzorbo island you can grab a nice lunch at restaurant Venissa or Maddalena.
