Sightseeing

- 1** **Odin's Bridge**
Northern Europe's largest swing bridge with a 200 metre span.
- 2** **Odense Rowing Club**
Rowing club founded in 1904, whose purpose is to promote an active lifestyle for all ages.
- 3** **Mornsol**
Candle moulding, creative and graphic workshop with coffee bar.
- 4** **Odense Motorboat Club**
Be careful when entering the harbor due to narrow passages.
- 5** **Promenadebyen**
Modern apartment blocks.
- 6** **North Atlantic House**
A cultural centre that brings together Greenlandic, Icelandic, Faroese and Danish culture under one roof.
- 7** **Byens Ø**
Recreational and cultural area with free access to toilets (disabled toilets) and drinking water.
- 8** **Odense Harbor Bath**
33 metre long harbor bath raised above the water.
- 9** **The FAF Building**
Former feed factory built in 1962.
- 10** **Sailing and Motorboat Club**
Cosy little harbor just 15 minutes from Odense city centre.

Harbor rules



Prohibited area

Sailing in areas marked in red is prohibited due to shallow water or because the area is restricted for our boats.



No swimming from the boat

You are not allowed to jump off the boat for swimming etc.



One way traffic

The arrows mark the direction of the traffic in the canals. It is prohibited and dangerous to sail against the traffic.



Picnic area

Picnics and anchoring are permitted in these areas. Remember that at least one person must remain on the boat at all times.



Fishing lines

Please be aware of fishers and their fishing lines. Don't sail too close as the boat will clip the lines which will block the propeller.



Toilet

Use the designated toilet spots marked on the map. Do not use the harbour or its surroundings as a toilet. Please show respect to our neighbours.
