THE NORTH ROUTE

1. BELLMOUTH PASSAGE

Drive carefully through the wind and pay attention to the oncoming boats.

2. BIG EASY

Go around the special markers in the water.

3. ADAMS PLACE BRIDGE

(Low Bridge Ahead) At this point you will have to turn around, GoBoat is not allowed here.

4. BLACKWALL BASIN

(Residential Area, keep quiet) You will not be able to use the other exits, as it's off-limits.

THE SOUTH ROUTE

On this route, you will be able to moor up, enjoy the view and also have a nice picnic. (Picnic signs only)

When you are exploring South Dock keep in mind that another 2 companies will be around, paddleboards and the sailing club.

The off-limits here are:

- 5. MARSH WALL BRIDGE
- 6. SOUTH DOCK DLR BRIDGE
- 7. CANAL AND RIVER TRUST YARD

The docklands is a commercial harbour. As such it does have a statutory harbour authority who have responsibilities for the safety of all the harbours users. Please be respectful of this and adhere to any requests given by the harbour authority.

- Respect other canal users
- Keep **noise** to a **minimum** (Music systems are not allowed on the boat.)
- Do not throw things in the water. Rubbish must be kept in the boat
- The designated captain must remain sober
- Guests must always **stay in the boat** except in emergencies

PICNIC

NO STOPPING

Out of respect for our neighbours, it is prohibited to stop in areas marked with this sign. Blackwall Basin is a residential area.



BOATING PROHIBITED

Red markings indicate either very shallow water or areas our boats aren't allowed to go. Stay out of these areas at all times



SHALLOW WATER!

Pay attention to the yellow buoys! They indicate that the water is shallow and you are at risk of hitting ground.



OUIET ZONES

Please keep the noice level to a minimum and turn off the music in the guiet zone.



IN HIGH WIND

Allow for longer sail times and beware that choppy conditions can impact the boat perfomance.
